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Cloud services, Internet of Things, Independent Third Party: new opportunities for CROs?

The EUCROF New Technologies working group aims to keep EUCROF members informed of new technologies that can improve clinical trials and position EUCROF as an expert and key stakeholder for the EU regulatory bodies (such as EMA).

Topics discussed within the group include:

- the reuse of EHR (Electronic Health Records) for clinical research
- the use of new technologies (such as the “Internet of Things”) to improve clinical trials and the challenges involved in using these new technologies
- review of associated regulatory guidances, both within the member states of EUCROF and internationally
- how our members (CROs) are affected by issues being pursued by sponsors, such as the use of “Big Data”

This presentation will bring listeners up to date on the latest work performed by the working group as well as the challenges we see in both the immediate future and in the longer term.
